INTRODUCTION

On Sunday February 19, 1989 while on duty in the Identification Division, I, Deputy G. Talmadge, unit 7116, received information from Communications that an ID unit was requested at 6330 Skyview in reference to a death investigation. I received the information at about 1:30PM. I went enroute and arrived at the scene location at about 2:08PM.

Upon my arrival at the scene location, the following personnel were present:  
 Unit 441 Sergeant R. Byars,  
 Unit 4404 Deputy F. Flores (reporting Deputy),  
 Unit 3109 Detective B. Johnson,  
 Unit 9020 Investigator J. Evans of the Medical Examiner's Office.

SCENE SUMMARY

The scene location was the 6330 block of Skyview, which is a street that runs north and south between West Little York and Holly Hill. The 6330 block of Skyview is intersected by Cedarview Drive, which runs east to west between Brittmore and Overlook streets. The actual scene was located on Cedarview Drive, between Brittmore and Skyview.

INVESTIGATIVE NARRATIVE

I entered the scene area from Skyview street. I observed that there were no houses located on Cedarview between Brittmore and Skyview. There was a vacant lot located along the south side of the roadway. This vacant lot did not have any type of fence separating it from the roadway. There was a vacant lot located to the north of the roadway, which did have a fence. There was a red colored plastic barrel located along the north side of the roadway on Cedarview Drive. Upon closer examination of the barrel, it was found to contain one brown grocery sack which contained several items of trash, and one white plastic trash bag, which contained many items of trash. By standing over the barrel and looking inside, I could see that there was a body inside. I could see that the body had blond hair, and was caucasian. The white plastic trash bag and the brown grocery sack were on top of the body. The top of the victim's head was partially visible. There was some apparent blood on the head of the victim. There was also some apparent blood on the white plastic trash bag, and on the brown grocery sack. There was also some apparent blood on the inside of the barrel near the head of the victim. There was a green plastic trash bag located on the ground near the barrel.

I took several color photographs of the scene area.

INVESTIGATIVE NARRATIVE(cont' from page one)

I took several measurements of the barrel containing the body in relation to the roadway. The barrel was located approximately sixty-three and one-half feet(63½') from the stop sign located at the east side intersection of Cedarview and Skyview. The barrel was located approximately twelve feet six inches(12'6")from the center of the Cedarview roadway. There was a neighborhood crime watch sign that was located on the north side of the Cedarview roadway. The barrel was located approximately nine feet two inches(9'2")east of this sign.

Investigator Evans and Detective Johnson advised me that the barrel containing the body would be transported intact to the Harris County Morgue.

I left the scene area on Cedarview and proceeded to the Harris County Morgue located at 1885 Old Spanish Trail. Upon my arrival at the morgue, the brown grocery sack and the white plastic trash bag were removed from the barrel. I took several photographs of these items. Once the grocery sack and trash bag were removed, I could clearly see the body of the deceased. The deceased was a white female, with blond hair. The body was completely naked. The body was positioned in the barrel with the buttocks resting against the bottom, with the legs drawn up toward the chest, the arms crossed, and the head against the side of the barrel and tilted downward. There was some apparent blood on the head of the deceased, and also on the side of the barrel near the head.

I took several additional photographs of the deceased in the barrel.

The body of the deceased was removed from the barrel and placed on a gurney. Upon close examination of the body, a wound was found on the head of the deceased. The wound was located on the right side of the head, about two inches(2")above the right ear. The wound was approximately one-fourth(¼")inch in diameter. I did not find any other wounds to the body.

I took several additional photographs of the deceased, and also of the wound area. I also obtained two sets of fingerprints from the deceased.

Upon closer examination of the barrel, I observed a small amount of apparent blood in the bottom. There was also a small amount of dirt in the bottom of the barrel. I took an additional photograph of the empty barrel.

At this time I returned to the Identification Division office with the following items of evidence:

EVIDENCE

1. one forty-four(44)gallon barrel, red in color, with name of Budweiser Beer imprinted on it,
2. one brown grocery sack containing several miscellaneous items of trash,
3. one white plastic trash bag containing several miscellaneous items of trash,
4. one green plastic trash bag(empty),
5. two sets of fingerprints of the deceased,
6. scene and morgue photographs.

Upon my return to the Identification Division office, a search of the fingerprint files was made. A fingerprint card was found matching the fingerprints of the deceased. The name was Collins, Shawnte Dawn, a white female, SPN#00801676, SO#388967.

I secured the evidence that I recovered in this case in the Identification Division Crime Lab, for processing at a later date.

FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION(cont')

On Sunday February 19,1989 while at my residence, I received a phone call from Detective B. Johnson requesting me to process the evidence recovered in this case. I returned to the Identification Division office at approximately 10:00PM, and with the assistance of Corporal R. Anderson, and Deputy M. Heffler, I began processing the evidence.

I began with the brown grocery sack. This sack contained several items of trash, such as a white plastic trash bag, which was empty, a blue disposable cigarette lighter, a Totino's Pizza box, a Budweiser Beer twelve(12) pack carton, a white paper towel which had some red stains which appeared to be blood, a plastic hot dog weiner package, two empty vegetable cans, and some other pieces of trash.

The above items were processed for latent prints. I recovered two latent prints of possible value from the plastic hot dog weiner package, and two latent prints of possible value from the Budweiser Beer carton.No other prints of value were recovered.

The brown grocery sack, the Budweiser Beer carton, the white paper towel, the plastic hot dog weiner package were retained. All other items of trash from the brown grocery sack were photographed and thrown away.

The white plastic trash bag containing several items of trash was the next item to be processed. I opened the bag and removed the items to be processed. The bag contained several items such as, a Busch Beer twelve(12) pack carton, several Busch beer cans, several Budweiser beer cans, a Corona beer bottle, a Coke bottle, a plastic two(2) liter bottle of Coke, a empty Marlboro cigarette package, and other miscellaneous items of trash.All of the beer cans and bottles were empty.

The above items were processed for latent prints. No prints of value were recovered.

The white plastic trash bag, along with a piece of paper found in the bag that had the name of "Hermano"on it were retained. All other items found in the white trash bag were photographed and thrown away.

The red barrel which contained the body, and the empty green trash bag found on the ground near the barrel were processed next. No prints of value were recovered from either item.
